

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS REGARDING COVID:

Question: What do I do if I have a medical emergency at home?

Answer: ***Call 911***

Question: What do I need to do if I've traveled out of state?

Answer: ***Self-quarantine (stay at home) for 6 to***

8 days. Call Wadatika (573-8050) to schedule an appointment to have a quick COVID test done 2 to 5 days after you have returned home.

Question: What do I do if I think I may have symptoms of COVID?

Answer: ***Call Wadatika with a list of your symptoms. If you need to schedule a quick COVID test you will be given an appointment time to come to Wadatika. If we are not open, please call Harney County Health Department (573-2271) to arrange for a test. You are responsible for your own transportation.***

Question: What if I just took a test and was told to stay home until they contact me? Is there someone I can call for any type of help?
