Transit staff would also like to bring to the attention of riders. Please be respectful of our drivers. The Tribal transit does have a route deviation policy in place, this means that we are able to take special requests within a timely manner from riders.

The schedule that we currently have set in place is not an exact time frame of stops depending on the request that we may have along the route. If the bus has not arrived at a certain stop at the time given, please give it a little bit of time, or call the transit bus phone at 541-413-0057.

TRANSIT BUS RULES

Seatbelt Use is required.

No Food or Drinks except for Bottled Water.

No Defacing of Interior/Exterior of the Bus.

No Smoking, please.

No Animals, unless in a small cage or carrier.

Radios with use of headphones Only.

Illegal, Violent, or Seriously Disruptive Behavior is Prohibited.

No Standing While Bus is in motion.

No Alcohol or Drugs will be transported on the Bus.

The Driver Retains the Right to Refuse Service. “Violations of Any of the above Rules will result in a suspension of all Transportation Services through the BPT Transit Program and may result in Civil or Criminal Charges.”
